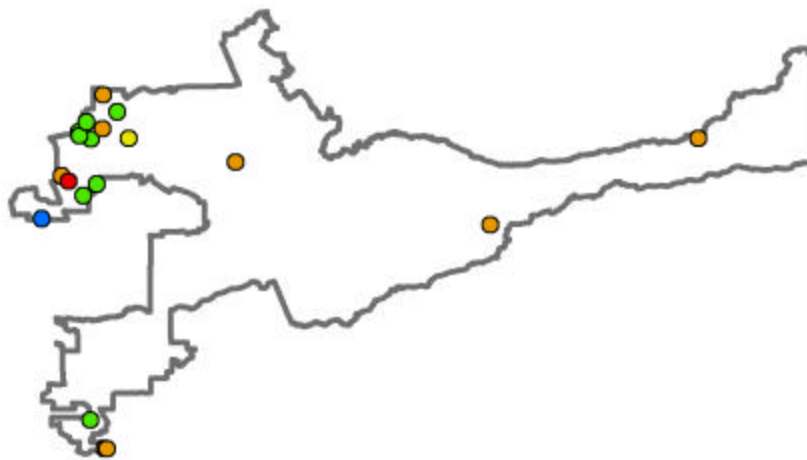


### UC in Your District

### UC DAVIS AND UC DAVIS MEDICAL CENTER

UC Davis is a premier research university, the largest employer in Yolo County and has an annual economic impact of more than \$1.4 billion. **The UC Davis Medical Center - near District 10**, is the region's only academic medical center and ranks among the nation's best hospitals. **The Medical Center operates an AIDS Clinical Trial Unit, a Nursing Research Center and the Center for Health Services Research in Primary Care, which provides research on primary care costs and quality.** The UC Mondavi Center for the Performing Arts hosts a wealth of cultural and artistic performances in District 10.

### UCD VET MED

The Veterinary Teaching Hospital at UC Davis **is the only veterinary teaching hospital in California and provides services to more than 27,000 animals each year.** UC Davis' Center for Equine Health (CEH) is leading the way in research to unravel the mysteries of colic, the painful abdominal malady that is the number one killer of horses. The **School of Vet Medicine's new Kenneth L. Maddy Equine Analytical Chemistry Lab** will provide drug testing for **California racehorses as well as studies evaluating the effectiveness of medications and other products on racehorse performance.**

### UC GENOMICS INSTITUTE

**The UC Riverside Genomics Institute** brings together faculty from every academic unit on campus to foster innovations that will make possible advancements in the quality of life, from greater productivity in **California's \$27 billion agricultural industry** to improved human health and environmental quality.



**UC's MESA (Mathematics, Engineering & Science Achievement)** works to prepare educationally disadvantaged students for four-year colleges at **87 K-12 school sites in the greater Sacramento area. MESA works with Sheldon High in District 10.** <http://mesa.ucop.edu>

**The Asian Research Program** (coordinated through the UCSF-Fresno Medical Center) works to improve the health of valley residents, who are of Asian origin, through research, teaching, and service.



**VA Northern California Health Care System** is an affiliate of the **UC Davis Medical Center**, and provides a full range of medical care to **over 417,000 veterans in the region.** The system includes the **Sacramento VA Medical Center in District 10**, which offers a wide range of medical and surgical inpatient and outpatient programs and services. <http://www.va.gov>

**The wine industry** in this district is heavily dependent on UC Davis' pioneering technology and innovative cultural practices. Selection of better yielding clones of chardonnay fueled a dramatic increase in planted acreage since 1960, bringing its current crop value to \$300 million.



**UC's Early Academic Outreach Program (EAOP)** has provided academic support, career advising, college counseling, motivational and skill building workshops to help over 85,000 California students realize their dreams of a college education. **EAOP works with 30 schools in the greater Sacramento area, including Albert Einstein Middle and Tokay High in Lodi in District 10.** <http://www.eaop.org>

**UC's California Subject Matter Projects** develop teacher knowledge in K-12 subjects by enhancing instructional strategies and improving **teacher retention and support systems** at over 500 California school districts. The program works with teachers at **several Sacramento and Lodi area K-12 schools.** With the expertise of teachers and UC faculty, the program annually trains thousands of teachers through intensive summer courses. <http://csmp.ucop.edu>

**The FARMS** program aims to empower high school students about their futures through experiential learning and exposure to educational and career choices - all centered on agriculture. **The UC Davis Mondavi Center's Arts Education and Community Outreach Programs** provide an imaginative, accessible way for people of all ages to discover, understand, and appreciate the performing arts through performances, teacher's guides, and pre-matinee classroom talks. In 2001-2002, 25,000 K-12 students were served across El Dorado, Placer, **Sacramento**, Solano and Yolo counties. <http://www.mondaviarts.org>

**The UC Davis Animal Ambassadors** program uses web-based and hands-on interaction with animals to foster children's interest in science. The program uses interactive materials and written curriculum for classrooms that develop scientific inquiry and critical thinking skills. Between 3,500 - 4,000 children participated in the program between 1999-2002. **The program is active in schools throughout Sacramento County.**



**The UC Davis Mathematics Project (UCDMP)** serves teachers and school districts throughout the entire **Central Valley and into the lower reaches of the Sierras.** UCDMP offers a variety of programs for mathematics teachers, including two tiers of intensive Summer Institutes that provide teachers from K-Community College the opportunity to develop problem solving strategies, learn new math content and instructional techniques.

**UC Division of Agriculture and Natural Resources Cooperative Extension offices in Sacramento and Amador Counties** provide accessible and comprehensive agricultural research information for local growers, ranchers, governments and the larger community. UC advisors provide research-based information in several languages on topics such as crop production, pest control, food safety, nutrition, youth development and water quality. <http://ucanr.org/>

**The UC Davis Health System is a leader in the field of "Telemedicine."** The program electronically links hospitals and primary care practices in rural areas to the UC Davis Medical Center in order to allow physicians to care for their patients locally.

**The UC Davis Western Institute for Food Safety and Security** is dedicated to food safety and security research and education. The institute is a partnership between UC, the Department of Food and Agriculture and the Department of Health Services.
