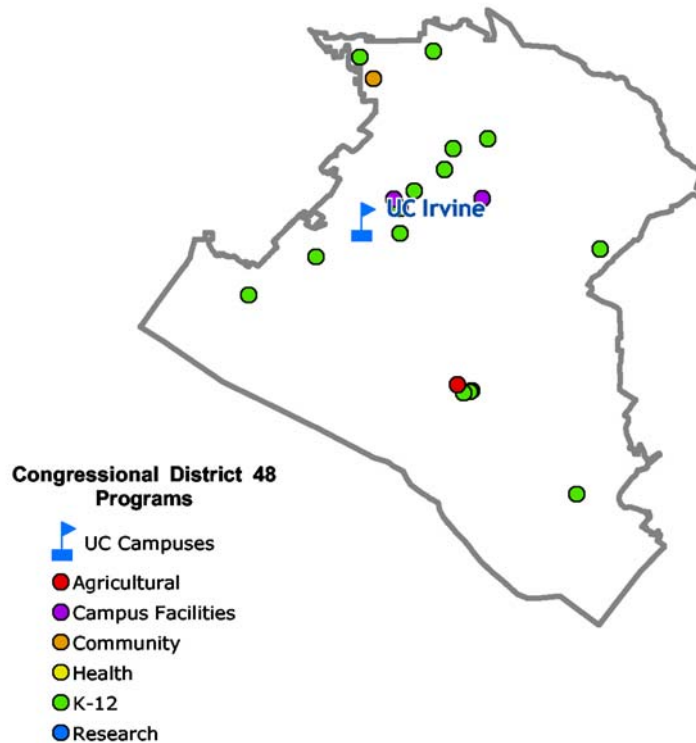


UC in Your District

THE UC IRVINE MEDICAL CENTER

UC Irvine Medical Center has a strong reputation in neurosciences, cancer and genetics research. **The UC Irvine Medical Center in Orange** provides cutting-edge medical research to the general population and to a disproportionate share of the area's indigent and uninsured populations. **The UC Irvine Medical Center's 462-bed facility is Orange County's only designated comprehensive emergency service center and Level I Trauma Referral Center.**

CALIFORNIA INSTITUTE FOR TELECOMMUNICATIONS AND INFORMATION TECHNOLOGY

To help ensure that California maintains its leadership in the rapidly changing telecommunications and information technology marketplace, **UC San Diego and UC Irvine have created the California Institute for Telecommunications and Information Technology (Cal-IT)².** The institute teams UC researchers with leading California telecommunications and computer companies to conduct research on the scientific and technological components needed to bring wireless technology to the next level. **Research sites are housed at UC San Diego and UC Irvine.**

The UC Irvine Gifted Students Academy was developed to assist gifted students in setting their sights toward a scholarly collegiate experience. UC's California Subject Matter Projects develop teacher knowledge in major K-12 subject areas by enhancing instructional strategies, providing access to the techniques that improve student achievement, and developing 'teacher-leaders'. With the expertise of teachers and UC faculty, the program annually trains thousands of teachers through intensive summer courses **at several schools in District 48 - including Laguna Beach High.** <http://sep.uci.edu>

UC Irvine's Criminology Outreach Program familiarizes **students at K-12 schools in the 48th Congressional District** with college course content, introduces them to intellectual pursuits and involves students in the type of policy debates that occur in the field of criminology. www.cfep.uci.edu

The UCLA Mobile Eye Clinic provides free eye examinations to people without medical insurance or access to regular medical care. Three trips per week are made in the **greater Los Angeles** area to various schools, agencies working with abused and foster children, and community organizations serving low-income families, the elderly, and the homeless. Patients are given eye examinations, are referred for further treatment or eye surgery if needed. The program examines 5,000 people each year.



UC's Early Academic Outreach Program (EAOP) provides academic support, college counseling and skill-building workshops to help over 85,000 California students realize their dreams of a college education. EAOP works with **several K-12**

schools in the area, including Laguna Beach High and Corona del Mar High in Newport Beach - both in District 48. <http://sup.ucdavis.edu/>
