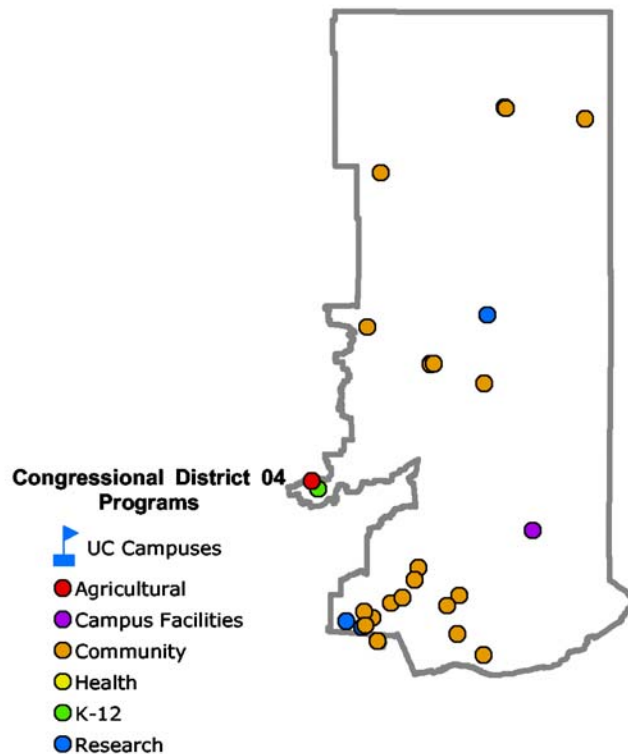


UC in Your District

UC DAVIS VET MED CENTER

The Veterinary Teaching Hospital at UCD is the only veterinary teaching hospital in California **and provides services to more than 27,000 animals each year.** UC Davis' Center for Equine Health (CEH) is leading the way in research to unravel the mysteries of colic, the painful abdominal malady that is the number one killer of horses. The School of Veterinary Medicine's new **Kenneth L. Maddy Equine Analytical Chemistry Lab** will provide drug testing for California racehorses as well as study and evaluate the effectiveness of medications and other products on racehorse performance.

EAGLE LAKE FIELD STATION

The UC-affiliated **Eagle Lake Field Station in Susanville** conducts practical and cutting-edge environmental research and offers a variety of field courses and visiting programs on such topics as surveying, wildlife and fish biology.



UC's MESA (Mathematics, Engineering & Science Achievement) works to prepare educationally disadvantaged students for four-year colleges at **K-12 schools and community colleges sites in the North State. MESA works with Las Plumas High in Oroville and Butte**

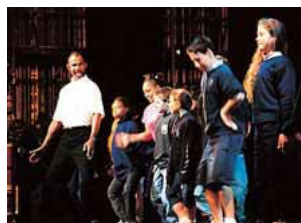

The UC Davis Mondavi Center's Arts Education and Community Outreach Programs provide an accessible way for people of all ages to appreciate the performing arts through performances, teacher's guides and pre-matinee classroom talks. In 2001-2002,

The UC Davis Animal Ambassadors program uses web-based and hands-on interaction with animals to foster children's interest in science. Between 3,500 - 4,000 children participated in the program between 1999-2002 **in schools throughout Yolo, El Dorado, San Diego, San Luis Obispo, San Mateo, Marin, Glenn, Tehama, Los Angeles and Sacramento counties.**

The UC Davis Health System is a leader in the field of "Telemedicine". The system has electronically linked hospitals and primary care practices in rural areas to the UC Davis Medical Center in order to allow physicians to provide services for their patients.

The UC Davis Burn Center serves the two million residents of Yolo, Sacramento, El Dorado, Nevada, Placer, Sierra, Sutter and Yuba counties. The center treats approximately 2,200 patients annually.

UC's California Subject Matter Projects develop teacher knowledge in K-12 subjects by enhancing instructional strategies and developing 'teacher-leaders'. With the expertise of UC faculty, the program is in over 500 California school districts and annually trains thousands of teachers through intensive summer courses. The Project is in place at **Johnstonville Elementary in Susanville.**

The UC Davis Mathematics Project (UCDMP) serves teachers and school districts throughout the entire Central Valley and into the lower reaches of the Sierras. UCDMP offers a variety of programs for math teachers, including intensive Summer Institutes. The Institutes provide teachers from K-

Community College the opportunity to develop problem-solving strategies, learn new math content and instructional techniques.

A UC system-wide multi-campus research unit, **the Center for Water and Wildland Resources** coordinates research on water conservation and flood management statewide.
