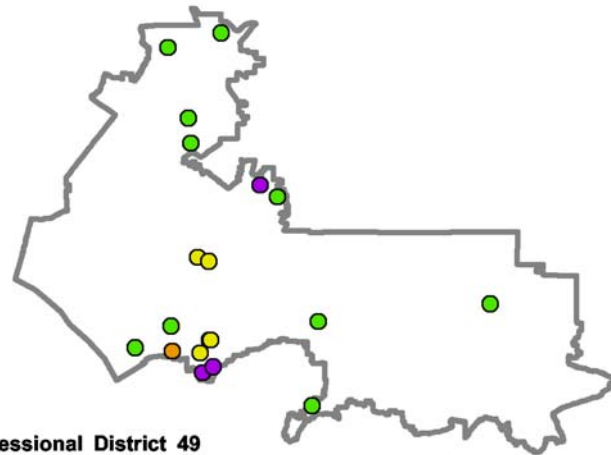


UC in Your District

UC RIVERSIDE

UC Riverside is the fastest growing of the UC campuses, has an annual economic impact of more than **\$360.2 million** and **is the third largest employer in Riverside County**. UC Riverside is a major research university with state-of-the-art facilities and a distinguished faculty that has led the nation in faculty honorees selected for the prestigious American Association for the Advancement of Science. The planned Riverside Technology Park, a partnership between UC, government and private industry, **will be a major research and development center** aimed at assisting local entrepreneurs and moving UC discoveries from the lab to the marketplace.



CALIFORNIA INSTITUTE FOR TELECOMMUNICATIONS AND INFORMATION TECHNOLOGY

To help ensure that California maintains its leadership in the telecommunications and info-tech marketplace, the **California Institute for Telecommunications and Information Technology (Cal-IT)²** teams UC researchers with leading California telecomm and computer companies to bring wireless technology to the next stage. Researchers will investigate how these technologies will bring advances in environmental science, transportation, biomedicine, education and transportation. Research sites will be housed at UC Irvine and UC San Diego.



UC VETERAN'S HEALTHCARE

The VA San Diego Healthcare System is an affiliate of the UCSD Medical Center and provides a full range of medical care to 238,000 veterans in San Diego and Imperial Counties. The system offers a wide range of inpatient and outpatient health services at the medical center in La Jolla and at the five community clinics located in Chula Vista, Escondido, Imperial Valley, Mission Valley and Vista.

The Philip L. Boyd Deep Canyon Desert Research Center is one of **34 UC-affiliated natural reserves in the state.** The site protects a diverse and unique habitat and serves as an important research site for environmental scientists. Another area

reserve is the **Jack and Marilyn Sweeney Granite Mountains Desert Research Center.** These UC-affiliated sites host a range of educational programs for local K-12 schools and the larger community. <http://nrs.ucop.edu>

The Community Teaching Fellowships in Math and Science, affiliated with the National Science Foundation and the UC Riverside School of Education, **work in the Riverside Unified School District** to improve teacher knowledge and student achievement in math and science. The UC managed Department of Energy national laboratories host several **K-12 science education programs.** The **Lawrence Berkeley Lab's award-winning Virtual Frog Dissection Web Site** is used in K-12 classrooms statewide.

UCLA's Regional Oncology Centers, affiliated with the world-renowned UCLA Jonsson Comprehensive Cancer Center, provide cancer care services and investigative clinical trials at a **satellite clinic in Vista.** Patients who come to UCLA centers for cancer care benefit from the most advanced forms of therapy available, and from a variety of supportive services.

UC's Division of Agriculture and Natural Resources Cooperative Extension provides comprehensive agricultural research information for local growers, ranchers, governments and the larger community at the **Riverside and San Diego county offices.** At these locations, UC also works to improve nutrition, reduce child obesity, ease the

transition from welfare to work and engage 4-H youth in educational activities.

Healthcare Access to Schools (HATS) helps children from low-income families obtain health insurance. Since its inception, UC San Diego has provided funds and technical assistance to dozens of schools, **including Fallbrook High in the 49th Congressional District.**

The UC Irvine Gifted Students Academy was developed to allow gifted students to experience the accelerated pace and advanced curriculum of college. The Gifted Students Academy has worked with students at **Fallbrook Street Elementary and Wildomar's Brown Middle School.**
