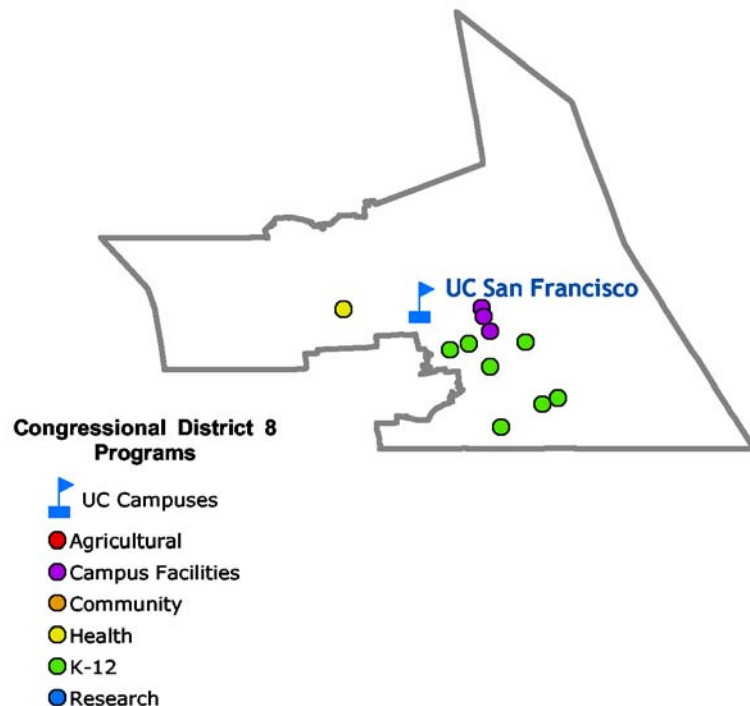

### **UC SAN FRANCISCO**

UC San Francisco is one of San Francisco's largest employers, contributing more than \$1 billion annually to the Bay Area economy and spawning hundreds of biotechnology enterprises. UC San Francisco has an internationally renowned faculty and is a leader in patient care, biomedical research, and graduate health science education. **The Medical Center, which is located in this district, consistently ranks among the best hospitals in the nation. With its affiliated hospitals, UCSF handles 50 percent of all hospital admissions in San Francisco.**

### **CALIFORNIA INSTITUTE FOR QUANTITATIVE BIOMEDICAL RESEARCH (QB 3)**

QB 3 is a cooperative effort between UC and private industry aimed at developing the cutting-edge research discoveries that will continue to drive the field of biomedicine. QB 3 will drive the new technologies and research that will spawn a host of biomedical innovations and train thousands of researchers. **QB 3 will be housed at two new buildings on the UCSC campus, a new UCB facility and a site at UCSF's Mission Bay campus.**

### **UC MANAGED DOE NATIONAL LABS**

The Lawrence Livermore National Laboratory (LLNL) and Lawrence Berkeley National Laboratory are both located near the 8<sup>th</sup> Congressional District and have a combined job base of 12,600. LLNL is one of the world's premier scientific centers, **where cutting-edge national security research is used to break new ground in energy, breast cancer and environmental research.** The Berkeley Laboratory boasts **nine Nobel Prizes and performs research in life sciences, energy efficiency, and accelerators.** Both laboratories host a range of K-12 and community outreach programs.

**UC Berkeley's Environmental Sciences Program and the Department of Ethnic Studies have worked in partnership with San Francisco's Galileo Academy of Science and Technology** and the Urban Watershed Project to implement a three-year high school environmental science course. The course incorporates field study, mentoring and web-based learning under the guidance of the **National Park Service at the Presidio in San Francisco.**



**UC Berkeley's Lawrence Hall of Science Alliance for Collaborative Change in School Systems (ACCESS)** works with the San Francisco Unified School District to strengthen the capacity of secondary schools to prepare students from historically under-

**The Public Law Research Institute at UC's Hastings College of the Law** serves California legislators and agencies by analyzing the legal issues that confront California's state and local governments. **UC's Early Academic Outreach Program (EAOP)** provides academic support, college counseling and motivational/skill-building workshops to help over 85,000 California students realize their dreams of a college education.

EAOP works with disadvantaged students in **37 high schools and 37 middle schools in Alameda, Contra Costa, San Francisco and Santa Clara counties.** <http://www.eaop.org>

**The Mental Health Research Group at UC Berkeley's School of Social Welfare** works with California counties to pursue timely research on issues in mental health such as residential care, psychiatric emergency services and homelessness. <http://socialwelfare.berkeley.edu>

**UC San Francisco's Breast Cancer Early Detection Program Regional Partnership** provides breast cancer screening, diagnostic services, and out-reach to low-income women over 40. <http://www.ucsfbreastcarecenter.org>

**UC San Francisco's research was among the first to identify HIV** as the causative agent of AIDS and the campus continues to lead in HIV treatment and research programs. **The UCSF AIDS Health Project** is the sole provider of HIV-specific mental health programs. **HIV InSite** is a web resource for treatment, prevention and policy that links UC expertise with academics, doctors and patients worldwide. <http://hivinsite.ucsf.edu>



**Nursing School faculty from UC San Francisco and CSU San Francisco** have partnered at the Valencia Health Services Clinic, to provide **primary health care to 2,650 infants, children and adolescents in San Francisco.** The clinic

combines UC's expertise in pediatric, women's health, and family primary care medicine with CSU's experience in case management and public health.

**Both the Livermore and Lawrence Berkeley National Laboratories are committed to enhancing community welfare, quality of life, and educational excellence through a variety of community efforts and programs.** The Berkeley Laboratory hosts an award-winning **Virtual Frog Dissection Web Site** designed for

classrooms statewide. The Livermore Laboratory's **Expanding Your Horizons Project** nurtures K-12 girl's interests in math and science and encourages them to choose careers in these fields by providing **Bay Area K-12 schools** with hands-on workshops led by women scientists and engineers.
