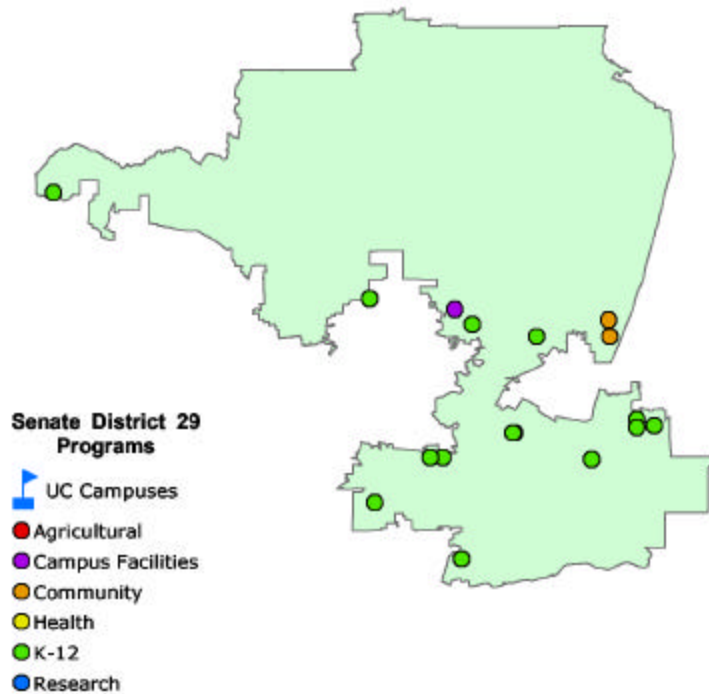


### UC in Your District

### UCLA MEDICAL CENTER

**UCLA Medical Center provides services throughout District 29** and is ranked # 1 in the West by U.S. *News and World Report*. More than 300,000 people – including a disproportionate share of the state's poor and uninsured – come to UCLA Medical Center each year **and receive the best in comprehensive care**. UCLA's Mattel Children's Hospital **offers a full range of specialty health services for children**. The Medical Center serves as a highly acclaimed training site for physicians, **many of whom choose to stay at UCLA** and as a **preeminent research center that drives innovations in life-saving drugs and surgical procedures**.

### UCLA

**UCLA- near District 29, is one of the country's top 10 research universities** with more than 100 majors offered to undergraduate students. **UCLA has a \$4.34 billion annual economic impact on the state economy**. The UCLA faculty is distinguished internationally – **with five current Nobel Laureates**. **UCLA postgraduate schools** include renowned schools of Education, Engineering, Law, Medicine, Nursing, Public Health, Public Policy and Theater, Film and Television.

### THE CALIFORNIA NANOSYSTEMS INSTITUTE (CNSI)

CNSI will facilitate a **public/private approach to developing the information, biomedical, and manufacturing technologies that will dominate science and the economy in the 21st century**. The Institute will provide a world-class intellectual and physical environment that **supports collaboration among California's university, industry and national laboratory scientists**. The Institute will be housed at **UCLA and UCSB** and will include corporate-sponsored incubator labs.



**The Puente Project** runs programs at 51 community colleges and 35 high schools throughout California to increase the enrollment and retention of educationally underserved students in four-year universities. Puente works

at schools throughout the **Anaheim Unified School District and the Whittier Unified School District as well as at Pasadena City College.** Puente students graduate from four-year universities at twice the average rate.

**UC Irvine's Chemistry Outreach** program has teams of graduate and undergraduate students visit Orange County schools to perform demonstrations and talk about chemistry. Since 1992, over 24,000 students have been reached – including at several schools in District 29 such as La Habra High. **ArtsBridge** is a UC arts education and outreach program that works with several K-12 schools in District 29, to provide high quality arts education. ArtsBridge also provides scholarships to qualified students to teach the arts and conduct arts-related workshops in local communities.

**Healthcare Access to Schools (HATS)** helps children from low-income families obtain health insurance in District 29. Since its inception, UC San Diego has provided funds and technical assistance to dozens of schools. <http://health.ucsd.edu>

**UC's California Subject Matter Projects** develop teacher knowledge in major K-12 subject areas by enhancing instructional strategies, providing access to the techniques that improve student achievement, and developing 'teacher-leaders' – at over 500 California school districts. With the expertise of teachers and UC faculty, the program annually trains thousands of teachers through intensive summer courses at schools throughout District 29 – including intensive science programs run at Arovista Elementary in Brea and El Dorado High in Placentia.

**UC Irvine's Criminology Outreach Program** familiarizes local students with college course content, introduces intellectual pursuits and involves students in the type of policy debates that occur in the field of criminology. [www.cfep.uci.edu](http://www.cfep.uci.edu)

**The UC Irvine Gifted Students Academy** was developed to assist gifted students to set their sights toward a scholarly collegiate experience. **UCLA's Regional Oncology Centers**, affiliated with the world-renowned UCLA Jonsson Comprehensive Cancer Center, provide cancer care services and investigative clinical trials at the **Wilshire Oncology Clinic satellite offices in Glendora, Pomona and West Covina.** Patients who come to UCLA centers for cancer care benefit from the most advanced forms of therapy available, and from a variety of supportive services. <http://www.cancer.mednet.ucla.edu/clinical>



**UC's MESA (Mathematics, Engineering & Science Achievement) Program** works at over 10 schools in District 29, including **Kraemer Junior High in Placentia** - to prepare educationally disadvantaged students for four-year colleges. <http://mesa.ucop.edu>

**The UCLA Mobile Eye Clinic** provides free eye examinations to over 5,000 people a year in the greater Los Angeles. The mobile clinic visits schools, agencies working with abused and foster children and the elderly, and homeless shelters.

**UC Riverside's CE-CERT** program contributes to improved environmental quality and energy efficiency through interdisciplinary research and by providing educational opportunities for the next generation of engineers, scientists and policy-makers in the region. <http://www.cert.ucr.edu>



**UC's Early Academic Outreach Program (EAOP)** has provided academic support, college counseling and skill-building workshops to help over 85,000 California students realize their dreams of a college education.

**UC Cooperative Extension in Orange, San Bernadino and Los Angeles counties** is coordinating management of the San Gabriel River and its watershed in the San Gabriel Mountains, to enhance the potential for wildlife habitat, groundwater recharge and water quality. <http://ucanr.org>



**UC Irvine's San Joaquin Freshwater Marsh Reserve** located near District 29 represents one of the last remnants of freshwater wetlands that once covered much of Orange County's flood plain.
