Dear Colleagues:

As part of the continuing restructuring of the activities of the Office of the President, I write to advise you of certain changes in the reporting structure within OP. Effective immediately, Executive Vice President Katie Lapp will assume oversight for the federal governmental relations, communications, alumni affairs, advocacy and institutional advancement units within OP. This new arrangement will ensure even greater coordination among the key components of external affairs as Katie is already overseeing State governmental relations. Incoming President Mark Yudof anticipates a new structure for these activities, and he has requested that Katie manage these offices in the near term until a new organizational structure has been developed to ensure effectiveness of all of these operations.

Executive Vice President Bruce Darling will continue his responsibilities vis-à-vis the OP Laboratory Management Office and work with The Regents with respect to their oversight of the national labs.

Over the next several months, incoming President Yudof intends to assess the current management structure with respect to the responsibilities of the executive vice presidents.
