**APPOINTMENT SALARY FOR ENRIQUE J. LAVERNIA AS PROVOST AND
EXECUTIVE VICE CHANCELLOR, DAVIS CAMPUS**

RECOMMENDATION

The President recommended that the Committee on Compensation recommend to the Regents approval of the following items in connection with the appointment salary for Enrique J. Lavernia as Provost and Executive Vice Chancellor, Davis Campus:

- (1) Per policy, appointment salary of \$307,500 (SLCG Grade 111: Minimum \$267,700, Midpoint \$344,000, Maximum \$420,100) as Provost and Executive Vice Chancellor, Davis campus. This represents a 24.6 percent increase in Mr. Lavernia's current base salary of \$246,800.
- (2) This appointment is 100 percent time and effective for a three-year term beginning on January 1, 2009 through December 31, 2011, pending approval by the Regents.

Additional items of compensation include:

- Per policy, Standard Pension and Health and Welfare benefits and standard Senior Management benefits, including Senior Manager Life Insurance, Executive Business Travel Insurance, and Executive Salary Continuation for Disability.
- Per policy, an automobile allowance of \$8,916 per year.
- Per policy, ineligible for participation in the Senior Management Supplemental Benefit Program due to dual faculty appointment.
- Per policy, accrual of sabbatical credits due to dual faculty appointment.

The compensation described above shall constitute the University's total commitment until modified by the Regents and shall supersede all previous oral or written commitments.

BACKGROUND

In fall 2007, the Davis campus undertook a national search to fill the position of Provost and Executive Vice Chancellor following Virginia Hinshaw's departure. However, the state's worsening budgetary circumstances have led the campus to suspend the search. The Chancellor believes that the campus will be best served by having an experienced UC Davis administrator serve as Provost and Executive Vice Chancellor for a three-year term so that the current challenges can be addressed by leadership knowledgeable about the campus and its consultative and budgetary processes.

Enrique J. Lavernia, currently Dean of the College of Engineering, has agreed to serve in this role beginning January 1, 2009 through December 31, 2011. Mr. Lavernia has served with distinction as Dean since September 1, 2002, overseeing one of the nation's fastest growing engineering schools with 12 majors, more than 200 faculty and 4,200 graduate and undergraduate students.

Previously he was a faculty member in the Department of Chemical and Biochemical Engineering and Materials Science at UC Irvine, where he served as Chair from 1998 through 2002. He has published over 400 journal articles and 200 conference publications.

Barbara A. Horwitz has been serving as Acting Provost and Executive Vice Chancellor for the period July 1, 2007 through June 30, 2008. In a separate action, the Davis campus will also be seeking approval to extend her appointment for an additional six months ending on December 31, 2008.
