

## **BOARS Comprehensive Review Reports**

The attached reports were distributed to The Regents at the November 2002 and September 2003 meetings and were included in the materials for the second meeting of the Study Group in December 2003. We are again providing copies of these reports in order to facilitate a discussion at the March meeting of the ways in which these reports could be expanded to better serve the information needs of The Regents. These reports are also posted on the University's website, so they offer an important source of information for the general public as well.

In reviewing these reports, Study Group members may wish to give attention to the summary tables on the outcomes of each year's process, included in the body of the report (for example, on pages 3, 5, and 7 of the 2003 report), the discussion of key issues related to quality and reliability of the process (pages 12-19 of the 2003 report), and the appendices containing campus-level data and process descriptions. *Which additional data and discussion would be of greatest use to The Regents and others in understanding and monitoring the comprehensive review process?*
