**REGENTS MEETING IS MOVED TO THE WEST CENTER**

The regularly scheduled meeting of the University of California Board of Regents on Wednesday and Thursday (March 14-15) has been moved to the James E. West Alumni Center on the UCLA campus.

The Regents' meeting was originally to be held at Covell Commons at UCLA. The decision to move the meeting is due to the anticipated large number of demonstrators and the wish to avoid disrupting the student residential facilities and academic activities that take place in and around the Covell Commons area. The Regents previously met at the West Center for many years.

Parking for reporters will be available in Lot 6, on Westwood Plaza near the West Center. A press credential will be necessary to enter this lot. Nearby parking will be available for members of the public, who should stop at the information kiosk on Westwood Plaza for directions. TV trucks also should stop at the information kiosk for parking instructions.
